

Our Topic this Half-Term is
You and Me

We will begin the topic thinking about ourselves: what we look like, what we can do, things we like/dislike. We will then think about our families and friends: who they are, what they do, where we live and who lives with us. Children will also learn about keeping safe.

Mathematics

The main focus for this half term will be developing number skills, such as counting by rote, numeral recognition, one to one correspondence, sequencing numbers, using and applying related mathematical language such as more and less. We will look for these skills to be used confidently in a range of situations.

Literacy

Our story telling focus will be 'The Little Red Hen'. Children will listen to range of other stories related to the topic. We will teach daily phonic sessions using the Letters and Sounds programme. Sounds to practise and Tricky Words will be sent home regularly.

Physical Development

PE lessons for this half term will focus on different ways of travelling using our body and movement. Skills such as co-ordination and control, and spatial awareness will be developed. Development of fine motor skills will take place through activities such as cutting, drawing and letter formation.

Expressive Arts and Design

Through the arts, children will learn a range of new songs and action rhymes. Children will be encouraged to pay attention to detail when completing portraits as well as exploring colour mixing. Opportunities to create stories and engage in imaginative role-play will be available.

Understanding the World

Children will talk about similarities and differences between themselves and others. Children will learn about different family customs and routines. They will have opportunities to talk about past and present events in their own lives.

Communication and Language

Our curriculum will have a sharp focus on speaking and listening. These skills will be developed through circle time activities, role play and storytelling. Children will have the opportunity to respond to a range of questions.

Children will be given opportunities to develop confidence and independence in selecting resources. Through circle-time they will take turns and develop relationships with their peers and familiar adults. We will talk about our different feelings and how we show respect towards others.
