A few things you need to know

Book Bags: Please ensure the children bring their book bags to school every day. This is so we can read with the children and comment in their record books. It is also so we can send home any letters or information that you may need to know. Please make sure you check you child's book bag daily.



PE: PE will take place twice a week for each class. P.E kits need to be brought in at the start of term and can be taken home at half term for a wash. PE kits include, yellow t-shirt, navy blue shorts/tracksuit bottoms, plimsolls and white socks. Girls will need their hair to be tied up on these days for health and safety reasons.

Homework: Homework will be given out every Wednesday in a homework book. Homework is expected in the following Monday. If for any reason children cannot complete homework tasks please inform an adult.

Water bottles: Your child will need to bring in a full water bottle each day clearly labelled with their name on. The children will have access to their water bottles throughout the day.



Trips: Parents are welcome to come along on trips with us. Please inform us if you would like to help when a trip is coming up.



Communication: We are all more than happy to talk to you about any concerns, ideas or questions you may have. We are able to briefly talk to you in the mornings and at more length after school. If you would like to book an appointment to speak to one of us then please do so. If you are unable to come into school please send a note in with your child and we will reply ASAP.

Lunch: Please let your child's class teacher know if they will be having packed lunch.
