


'Let's Move!' Spring Term 2 Topic Summary **EYFS**

This half term the teaching focus will be on different types of Transport. In Literacy, we will be reading rhyming texts by Julia Donaldson and a selection of texts with a Transport theme including The Naughty Bus. Children will design and make their own transport model.



Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Happy Hearts - Continuing with Happy Hearts EYFS children will learn about keeping safe and healthy. This will include Road Safety, Internet Safety and Healthy Eating.



Expressive Arts and Design

Children will have opportunities to represent their own ideas through design and technology. The inside role-play area will be a travel agents enabling children to develop their topic related language skills.

Early Years Maths Mastery

Children will continue to explore numbers from 15 to 20 using a range of resources. They will continue to practise using mathematical language correctly to explain their understanding. Children will be introduced to Capacity and Time in practical situations and continue to learn about 2D and 3D shapes.

Communication and Language

Our curriculum continues to have a strong focus on speaking and listening. These skills will be developed through rhyming activities. Children will have the opportunity to respond to a range of questions. Specific vocabulary will be taught linked to our topic and children will be encouraged to listen and respond with relevant comments.

Physical Development

PE lessons for this half term will focus on different ways of travelling, including climbing and balancing. There will also be a focus on partner work and kicking balls. We will continue to develop fine motor skills through activities such as cutting, drawing, threading and letter formation. Health and Self-Care will focus on how to keep healthy by making healthy food choices.

Understanding the World

Activities will be planned where the children will explore different modes of transport, how they travel to school and their personal experiences of travelling. They will use computer programs to input simple information eg. Programming a beebot to move in a given direction. Towards the end of the term, children will be learning about Easter celebrations.

Literacy

World Book Week - Week Commencing Monday 27th February. Each class will have a different story focus. (see Book Week information)

Children will be looking at rhyming texts by Julia Donaldson throughout the term alongside books relating to transport including 'The Naughty Bus' and non-fiction texts about transport. Daily phonic sessions will continue using Letters and Sounds. New sounds and **tricky words** to learn will be sent home each week.
